In fact, before admitting their pow-
erful decisions, we must be obliged to
beg those gentlemen to make known
their acceptance of expressions; and to
ask them what they understand by "wi-
ness of wisdom of concession"; and to tell
if it is the tell or not in the President's
duty to undertake any measure that has
not originated in both houses of Con-
gress. If a President cap of his own
authority increase the national honour ;
and if he is not deserving our grati-
tude for having maintained the Repub-
lic in its proper rank among the nations
of the Globe ? Considering in the political
knowledge of those who drew up
those resolutions. We ask of them al-
so whether, they have duly considered the
importance and great weight of those
interests that agitate Europe since more
than two years, whether they have re-
flected on the difficulties that our cabi-
net must naturally have encountered in
preserving inviolate the national dignity
without engaging in any entangling
alliances with foreign powers, and by
whom the United States would have
riskened the being considered as but of
second importance, and from these
misfortunes we have not been preserved
by the profound policy of Mr. Adams
and Clay? Such are the questions we
would wish them to answer previous to
subscribing to a judgement as un-
becoming as it is void of common sense
concerning two most able statesmen.

We will not dwell on the question
that the present administration has had
an unhappy influence on our internal
prosperity.

Facts sufficiently give the lie to an
assertion so completely devoid of even
the semblance of truth. Never was the
internal navigation of the United States
so flourishing as it is at present. And
it is because our success has given uneasiness
to Great Britain, that she took
certain measures that might possibly
have disturbed the harmony between
the two nations, had it not been for the
address and noble stand taken of our
cabinet.

It is necessary that some specious
motives should be assigned, for accusa-
tions so positive and so severe as are
those contained in the resolutions of
Iberville ! But nothing, absolutely no
thing discriminates their vicious intention ! What then must we conclude
from their issue of incoherent proposi-
tions, of shocking expressions ? Nothing
else but that it is another proof to
what excess party spirit can lead man-
kind, nothing else but that they are the
offspring of reflecting hatred; that
tamped with the seal of gross im-
propriety, and of passion, they evince but
infidelity, but calumny that they are
but peccadilloes of persons lost astray by
their own exaltation; or to profit by the
exaltation of others to lead them astray.
