MEETING OF BANK COMMITTEES.

On Monday last, all the Banks in this city, represented by committees, held a meeting for the purpose of devising measures for the relief of the community at the present moment of unparalleled pressure. The following are the resolutions adopted on the occasion:

1. Resolved, That it is recommended to the various Banks represented in this assembly to adopt the following resolution:

2. Resolved, That this notes under discount (provided the notes be entitled to credit) shall upon application be reduced by ten per cent every sixty days until the first of December next.

3. Resolved, That it is understood circumstances should occur, detrimental to the interest of the Banks as creditors, to themselves the right of setting aside the arrangement after giving notice to all the other Banks.

4. Resolved, That the foregoing resolutions shall be binding as soon as all the Banks shall signify their concurrence to the president of this assembly.

5. Resolved, That a committee be appointed to request the master bank of the U. S. at Philadelphia, to authorize a branch at New Orleans to extend its discounts one hundred dollars, to expire the first of February next, or loan to the State Bank—per cent per annum interest, such amount as they may require, not exceeding five per cent on their capital, and loan to be repaid on the first of February.

6. Resolved, That a committee be appointed, composed of one representative from each Bank in this city to carry the foregoing resolutions so soon as they are adopted by the different Banks, and to call a meeting of our Representatives to Congress, Mr. R. King, and our Representatives, Messrs. Clay, Mardis, Murphy and McHenry.

7. Resolved, That a copy of the foregoing preamble and resolutions be forwarded by the Secretary of this meeting to the Board of Directors of the Branch Bank in New Orleans. The Union Bank, less than a week ago, sent a copy of the same to the Board of Directors of the State Bank.
