TWELFTH LEGISLATURE—First Session.

FATIGUE, Feb. 27th,

Mr. Leake presented a report from the joint committee appointed to examine the affairs and condition of the City of New Orleans. It contained chiefly a statistical description of facts without any remarks, except one acknowledging the contrary and readiness shown by the president and members of the committee to the committee. The report states that the capital of the company is \$2 million, and that its branches have been furnished with the specific capital of \$870,000. The notes on hand amount to \$405,215, the space to \$213,600, the deposits with interest to \$612,322, without interest to \$73,616, the bills discounted to \$1,960,017, and the balance to \$2,252,117. The directors own 591 shares of the stock, and are induced by themselves or the 100 to whom they belong, to the bank \$109,335—besides \$27,000 in loans on stock. There is a sum of \$26,926 under deposit, which the bank expects to recover.
