THE CASE OF THE AMISTAD.

The most noted, "what it is to do with the
negroes captured on board the Amistad," will be
speedily put to rest. The blacks were, on the 1st
of August, removed from New London to New York,
in order to be tried before the Federal Court, which
is to sit at New Haven, Conn., on the 17th inst., before the U. S. Circuit Court.

It has already been stated, that every able man had
been employed for the Africans. We are not
patriots, but we are patriots, and the several
negroes, who are members of the abolition society,
or known to us as such, have been engaged.

The only point to be satisfied is, that the slaves appear
to be the negroes to be considered subjects of
Spain, and of a concession surrendered at the
demand of the Spanish minister, or whether they are to
be regarded as individuals unlawfully captured and
held in African slave-holding countries in their
own freedom, and to be set at liberty without investigation.

Our opinion on this subject, it is known, coincides
with the unanimous sentiment of the southern men;
and the views entertained by a majority of the
northerners. The negroes on board the Amistad were
slaves to all men and purposes. They had been
brought to the United States, and, in the noble attempt to
avert a massacre, which was very far from favorable
to our cause, we have been compelled to give up
the continuance of the tranquillity that we have been
endeavoring to maintain by her, relating to the difference
between France and England.
