ALABAMA.

The message of Gov. FLETCHER, is principally

devoted to the monetary and banking affairs of

the State. It contains a number of alterations in the

constitution of the State, and a recommendation

to the Legislature, suggesting a change in the mode of

electing directors of the State Bank and branches, and

a curtailing of expenses in the management of them.

The Governor is in favor of a reduction of the bank's

capital of \$2,000,000 to \$1,500,000, and suggests the

policy of applying the surplus to the purchase of the bonds of the

State. He recommends that the Mobile branch of the State

Bank be put in liquidation; and that the Legislature

be empowered to issue bonds for the purpose of

the means of saving the holders of the notes of the

Bank from the loss of their property, in the event of

the suspension of the specie payments of the State.
