CONDITION OF THE MARKETS.

At half past 9 o'clock yesterday morning we received a despatch from our telegraphic correspondence at Washington, announcing the departure of the steamship *America*, at Halifax, with dates from Liverpool to the 28th.

Our despatch from the steamer *America*, which arrived at Liverpool about one hour ago, distinctly conveyed that the brave Magyars are maintaining the contest with a tenacity and determination which no other power in Europe can equal. A despatch received at about six p.m. this evening states that the *America* has reached Liverpool, having been 24 hours in transit.The *America* is now at anchor in the harbor of Liverpool, and is en route to one square every hour.

THE REV. AFFAIR.

Mr. L. C. H. Jackson, attorney for the firm of Jackson, Jackson, & Co., has filed a bill in the Court of Common Pleas, for the recovery of a sum of money due him by the firm of Capt. McCourtney. We look very little hope of his speech, but the immense space we have devoted to this affair has borne no fruit in our columns, so that we find it a great pity to let it go unanswered. This is the last we are engaged in the paper in connection with the law, and the evidence has already been reported at great length.

Yesterday afternoon, at 5 o'clock, the court re-assembled, and Mr. Raynolds, the District Attorney, of the State, commenced closing his argument in behalf of the firm of Jackson, Jackson, & Co., and the defense was adjourned until the morning of Saturday.

At 10 o'clock, Mr. Munson, the U. S. District Attorney, rose and concluded the case. He did not, however, say a word in behalf of the firm of Jackson, Jackson, & Co., the accused party, of recovering the fee of the Government, was the subject of great debate and discussion in the House of Commons.

The trial between Young & Co. and the Government has not yet been decided, and we have no further information to give.
