6 favor any legal or tacit mortgages may cast at the time of the passage of
7 this act; to have the special mortgage or mortgages, in this act required and
8 provided for, as the substitute for all legal or tacit mortgages, inacribed on
9 or before the first day of January, 1853, in the office of the Recorder of
10 mortgages, as in the several sections of this act directed, and in the manner
11 and form provided by law, for the inscription of conventional mortgages,
12 and to have the same re-inscribed at the time required by law, to prevent
13 prescription from taking effect against such special mortgage or mortgages,
14 until the same shall be cancelled in due course of law. And no legal or
15 tacit mortgage existing at the time of the passage of this act, shall be effec16 tive in law, and be hereafter executed in any of the courts of this State,
17 unless the same shall be substituted by special mortgage, and be inscribed
18 on or before the first day of January, 1853, in the office of the Recorder of
19 mortgages, as herein before directed, and in the manner and foma provided
20 by law, for the inscription of conventional mortgages.

Sec. 8. Be it further enacted, dcc., That whenever any certified or an2 thentic copy of any instrument or any inventory of property, rights, credits
3 and estate, or any statement and description of adjudicated mercerty as of

thentic copy of any instrument or any inventory of property, rights, credits and estate, or any statement and description of adjudicated property, or of and estate, or any statement and description of adjudicated property, or and dowery or dotal property, or any other document or instrument of writing, required and directed by any of the provisions of this act, to be filled in the office of the Recorder of mortgages, in any of the saveral parishes of the State, it shall be the duty of such Recorder, in whose office the same shall be filled, thereupon to record in full and at length all such copies, inventories, statements and descriptions, documents and instruments of write whatsoever, in the book or books of record, kept in such office in the party whatsoever, in the book or books of record, kept in such office in the tenno manner and form as conventional mortgages are now by law required to be recorded. And whenever certificates of the incumbrances existing upon property shall hereafter be required and given by the respective Recorders of mortgages of the several parishes of this State, it shall be the duty of such Recorders respectively to include anew in such certificates all special mortgages, filed in their respective offices under the provisions of this act, as incumbrances upon the property affected or covered by such special mortgages, for the amount and to the extent in such special mortgages goeified, until the same shall be cancelled in due source of law.

Sec. 9. Be it further enacted, &c., That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and all laws or parts of laws conflicting with this act, or contrary to any of its provisions be, and the same are hereby repealed.
