THE ERROR OF THIS ENEMY.

Until very recently the ignorance of our Northern enemies respecting the power, the resources, and the warlike experience of the South, was such that it was difficult to determine whether their knowledge on these subjects was not extremely incomplete and imperfect. It is quite certain that at the commencement of the war the Northern Generalissimo, General John C. Fremont, the Secretary of War, and the commandant of the Western Department, General John C. Frémont, had believed that the nature of our courage and determination were a sufficient and sufficient reason to insure a rapid and effective victory. He was also fully satisfied with all the works and preparations he made to make a prompt and effective resistance. The Yankees, consequently, were not willing to have their war carried on with a few months in a single campaign, and were desirous of getting over the Southern States, driving them out, whipping them thoroughly, and compelling them to submit, before the end of October.

It is now evident from the states of the North respecting the people of the South, that even now it is not fully known what they are fully capable of. The war has been fought out, and the intelligence is incomplete.
