Conditions of National Homogeneity.

Those who may adhere to the notion that the Union can be harmoniously conducted on the principle of reciprocal tolerance of sectional diversities, are surely in a fair position to argue that, if it is safe to sign legal documents, it is safe to sign them. It is, however, clearly ascertained that another in the trumpet's clangor and the canon's roar, it was the utter insufficiency of mere constitutional guarantees and inducements to secure that degrees of forbearance and non-interference which is essential to the success of the unity and integrity of the States. It is in the interest of all the people of a country to have a common language, a common religion, a common history, a common literature, a common literature, a common government, and, in order to be at peace and united under one common Constitution, the country must be rendered homogeneous in its various parts.

The conditions of the required homogeneity can be fully developed only by future experience. One of them, however, is absolutely obvious, the emancipation of slaves. It is uncertain that they will not tolerate quietly any laws relative to the negro in the South which bear the stamp of a peculiar and sectional character. Negro suffrage will undoubtedly be one of these conditions of national homogeneity.
