MAY SHUT SHEEP OUT

Interesting Pamphlet on Forest Growth and Sheep Grazing.

Forest Fires in the Cascade Mountains in Oregon Thought to Be Caused by Careless Sheep Herders.

The agricultural department has just issued an interesting pamphlet on the subject of forest growth and sheep grazing in the Cascade mountains of Oregon, prepared by Frederick V. Coville.

In general forest fires increase in the reserved region proportionately to the increase of human occupancy of all classes. It is clear as a result of careful inquiry, the pamphlet says, that at the present time sheep herders and packers are extremely careful to allow their camp fires to spread and not to set fire intentionally, though it is unquestionably true that in the early days of sheep raising there was a widespread belief among sheep men that burning of the forest was a positive benefit to the industry.

HARVARD FINDS NEW POET.

"Yiddish" Which He Uses a Peculiar Compound of German, Russian, Lithuanian and Hebrew.

New York holds a wonderful poet, says the correspondent of the Chicago Tribune. He was "discovered" by Prof. Lee Wiener, of Harvard university, in German or in Russian—he sings his lays in that strange language current among his people.

He is the Burns of the Ghetto, touching the heart by the homeliness of the subject and treatment, and yet it is a poetry of the highest order.

The "Yiddish" which he uses is a peculiar compound of German, Russian, Lithuanian and Hebrew, known and used by the masses that swarm in the Russian "pale," without grammar, elastic, embracing. It is difficult for anyone not to the manner born to understand this strange jargon, but for the people it is their language.

Perhaps now a new life is opening before this poet of the people. Prof. Seligman, of Columbia university, had him read in his parlors. Harvard college will listen to him next month, and Messrs. Copeland and Day, of Boston, are just about to issue a volume of his poems in the original with an English translation by Prof. Wiener.

HETTY GREEN AFTER STAYTON
