S'il est une institution dont la Nouvelle-Orléans ait besoin, c'est bien une Académie de Coupe de Vêtements pour hommes, femmes et enfants. Le grand succès que nous avons obtenu avec les académies établies dans les premières villes d'Europe et d'Amérique, nous fait espérer un égal succès à la Nouvelle-Orléans, attendu qu'un établissement de ce genre sera le seul en cette ville.

A l'avenir, ceux qui désireront étudier cet Art, si utile, indispensable même, ne seront plus forcés d'aller à l'étranger apprendre des coupes anciennes et surannées.

Le "Conformateur Peyry" est le système du vingtième siècle; c'est ce qui fait aux tailleurs pour hommes et pour femmes, aux modistes en robes et aux dames qui désirent confectionner elles-mêmes leurs vêtements.

Cette invention rivalise avec la machine à coudre quant à son utilité; et toutes les personnes qui s'intéressent à la coupe, à la confection et à l'élégance des vêtements des deux sexes, trouveront ce système scientifique d'une grande valeur pour le coupeur de peu d'expérience, et d'une grande utilité pour une personne expérimentée qui, ayant obtenu succès et renommée, désire pousser son savoir jusqu'à la perfection.

Le "Conformateur Peyry" est un système d'une grande précision appliqué à la coupe des vêtements, avec ou sans coutures. Il fonctionne de deux manières: s'ajuste aux mesures prises sur la personne et se conforme à toutes les courbes et prend les contours du corps horizontalement et verticalement. Breveté en 1899, et médaillé à l'Exposition Universelle de Paris en 1900, il est donc universellement recommandé. Le système est expliqué par un livre illustré renfermant 104 différents diagrammes et dessins. Les dames et les modistes pourront à première vue en comprendre les secrets, et quelques explications et un peu de pratique les rendront maîtres de cet art de la coupe. Des diplômes seront donnés aux élèves qui suivront un cours complet.

CHARTER.

STATE OF LOUISIANA - PARISH OF ORLEANS. CITY OF NEW ORLEANS.

BE IT KNOWN That on this fifth day of October, in the year of our Lord, One thousand nine hundred and seven, and of the Independence of the United States of America, three hundred and thirty first...

ARTICLE I. The name of this corporation shall be the CONSUMERS LUMBER MANUFACTURING AND EXPORT COMPANY, and under its said corporate name it shall enjoy corporate existence for the full term and period of twenty-one years, from and after the date hereof...

ARTICLE II. The domicile of this corporation shall be in the City of New Orleans, Louisiana, and the principal office of the corporation shall be in the City of New Orleans...

ARTICLE III. The objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized shall be to manufacture, produce, sell and export...

ARTICLE IV. The capital stock of said corporation is hereby fixed at the sum of Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) divided into and represented by 500 shares of one hundred dollars each...

ARTICLE V. All the corporate powers of said corporation shall be vested in and exercised by a Board of Directors to be composed of not less than three and not more than five members...

ARTICLE VI. Whenever this corporation may be dissolved, either by the expiration of its term or by any other cause, its affairs shall be liquidated by two commissioners to be appointed amongst the stockholders...

ARTICLE VII. This act of incorporation may be modified, changed or altered, or said corporation may be dissolved by the directors of this corporation...

ARTICLE VIII. No stockholder shall ever be held liable for the debts or liabilities of said corporation in any manner other than the unpaid shares of stock owned by him...

ARTICLE IX. D. A. Hackney, R. H. Hackney and William J. Young have been chosen and selected as the first Board of Directors of this corporation...

ARTICLE X. The undersigned, Recorder of Mortgages, in and for the Parish of Orleans, Louisiana, do hereby certify that the above and foregoing Act of Incorporation of the Consumers Lumber Manufacturing and Export Company...

ARTICLE XI. I, the undersigned, Recorder of Mortgages, do hereby certify that the above and foregoing Act of Incorporation of the Consumers Lumber Manufacturing and Export Company...
