UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, STATE OF LOUISIANA, PARISH OF ORLEANS, CITY OF NEW ORLEANS.

CHARTER

The name and title of the corporation hereby formed is to be the H. W. SLOAN & COMPANY, INC.

ARTICLE I

The domicile of this corporation shall be in the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana.

ARTICLE II

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized and established are:

ARTICLE III

The capital stock of this corporation is hereby fixed at ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00).

ARTICLE IV

EUSTIS, a notary public, duly appointed and qualified, and in and for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, aforesaid, and in presence of the witnesses hereunto named and undersigned, personally came and appeared the several persons whose names are hereunto subscribed, who severally declared that they were citizens of the law of the State of Louisiana, in such cases made and provided and particularly of the provisions of the Act of the Legislature of the State of Louisiana, for the year 1904, approved July 14th, 1904.
